Directions to camp:

From Boise: I-84 to Mountain Home. Take exit 95/Hwy 20 toward Fairfield/Mountain Home/Sun Valley – 83 miles. Turn left at Hwy 75 toward Ketchum – 26 miles.

From Ketchum to Camp: At the last stop light in Ketchum at Saddle Rd. continue 8 miles north. Turn right at Sawtooth National Recreation Area Headquarters (SNRA), continue 1.5 miles (the road changes to gravel), turning left onto bridge in to Camp.

What to bring:

Summer clothes, warm clothes for evening, rain gear (just in case!)

Bible, flashlight, close toed shoes for campfire time

Toiletries, towel (there are bathrooms with showers)

Sleeping bag, pillow, charging cords for your cell phone

Water bottle, insect repellent, sunscreen, and a snack to share!

There will be plenty of free time so bring what you would like for that time--hiking shoes, fishing gear, cameras, money for shopping, swim gear (there's a YMCA pool and Easley's Hot Springs Pool), a book to relax with by the river, etc.
